



The Executive Development in Policing course (EDP) session 2 applications will be received until May 24, 2006. This session is a combination of onsite and online learning that will take place between June 28th 2006 and June 15th, 2007.

The EDP course will strengthen participants' senior management skills, enabling them to be more effective members of the executive team. EDP is based on skills identified by police executives as critical - skills that they wish they had acquired before being promoted to their current positions. EDP will also prepare participants to understand the issues that are central to the work of every Canadian police executive.

EDP focuses on building individual effectiveness and teaches participants how to build more capable teams, teams that are able to tackle the challenges of an ever changing organizational and community environment.

EDP will expose participants to the expertise of nationally known police officers, government officials and academics and will provide them with opportunities for intense exchanges with their colleagues. EDP will do this through a combination of three face-to-face and three online sessions that together will span eleven months of learning geared to the real world challenges of police executives.
