In this role, you will be responsible for managing the day-to-day operation of Security Services at York University for both the Keele and Glendon campuses. In consultation with the Director, the Manager is responsible for providing effective, efficient and timely delivery of security services and emergency response to over 50,000 students, staff, faculty, and visitors that comprise the York University community. This is achieved through the management of Security staff and provision of initial response and follow-up to incidents, events and occurrences on the campuses, and by working collaboratively with a diverse community of students, staff and faculty to support safety incidents, issues and programs in an inclusive manner with tact, judgment and support. The Manager ensures that the Department provides high quality, customer-focused services to the York community according to the University's mission and the department's mission of Security Services. Additionally, this position, under the direction of or in the absence of the Director, may act as a designated representative for the Director when attending meetings with senior administration or the York community as a whole for the purpose of representing Security Services and ensuring timely and effective resolutions to issues raised.

To be considered for this opportunity, you will possess:

A Law and Security Administration degree or diploma from a recognized University or Community College or equivalent combination of education and experience. Professional designation in security management (e.g. ASIS Certified Protection professional [CPP], CSIS Accredited Security Professional [ASP] or Certified Security Professional [CSP]) or equivalent combination of education and experience is preferred. Professional designation in a security related field or related program would be an asset (e.g. Canadian Risk Management designation, Certified Fraud Examiner, etc.). Must possess a valid dual Ontario Security Guard and Private Investigators licence or be willing to obtain prior to employment.
